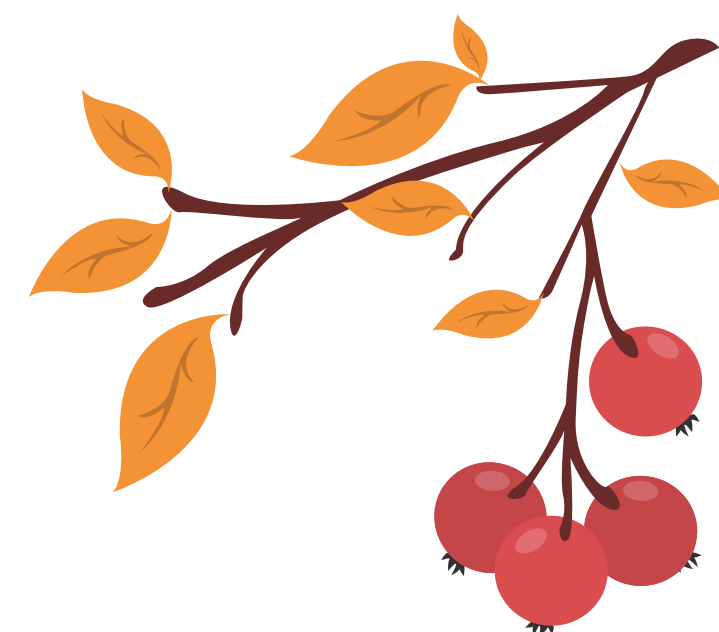

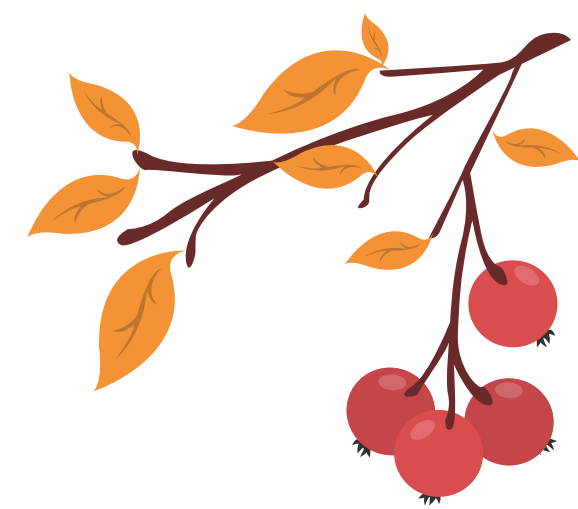

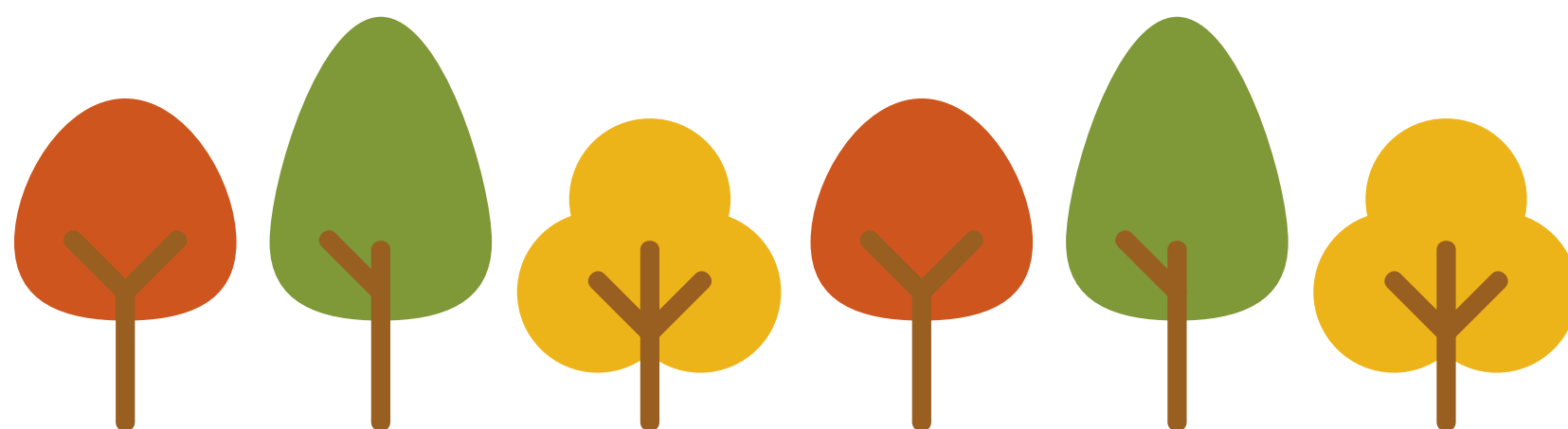
## Native American Culture Celebration
